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1. Discuss the request from Sheriff Murray to let bid for a 3-D laser scanner.
2. Discuss the ADA title II web & mobile application accessibility rule. The United States Department of Justice (DOJ) has adopted a new accessibility rule (28 C.F.R. §§ 35.200 to 35.205) that state and local governments must follow to ensure that their web content and mobile applications comply with Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). These requirements apply to web content and mobile apps that a public entity provides or makes available, directly or through contractual or other arrangements. Deadline is April 24, 2026.
3. Discuss adopting a resolution to establish ad valorem taxes.
4. Discuss the Trane contracts for the jail presented by Jason Goodgame at the last work session on Thursday, January 22, 2026, pending the County Attorney’s review.
5. Discuss plans to add offices and/or storage in the Pell City courthouse.
6. Discuss the request from Coroner Jeff Parrish for a generator & paving the alleyway behind the coroner’s office.
7. Discuss transferring a generator Inv #6664 from EMA to Argo.
8. Discuss wet County License fees for 2026-27.
9. Discuss the request from Sheriff Murray to approve a Berla software license in the amount of \$4,250/yearly, pending the County Attorney’s review. The software Allows for the extraction and examination of data collected from infotainment systems in vehicles. This often includes mobile device information as well as date, time and location-based vehicle information instrumental in investigations.

10. Discuss the request from Sheriff Murray to approve Carahsoft/Cellebrite subscription in the amount of \$36,927.24/yr, pending the County Attorney's review. This is on the OMNIA cooperative. This subscription allows law enforcement CPU and Mobile device examination and extraction tools which allow for evidence gathering from cell phones, electronic device search warrant returns, drones, and portable data storage devices. In particular, the Premium (SAAS) tool is required to attempt to gather such evidence when there is no cooperation from the suspect who was in possession of the mobile device.
11. Discuss the request of Public Transportation Director Janet Smith to pay an invoice without a purchase order to HD Supply in the amount of \$266.57 for cleaning supplies.
