TO ALL RETAIL VENDORS LOCATED OUTSIDE OF THE CITY LIMITS OF PELL CITY

DOES NOT APPLY TO STORES LOCATED INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF PELL CITY

Enclosed is the State of Alabama list of exempt and non-exempt items for the Severe Weather Sales Tax Holiday, February 20-22, 2026. Exempt items are in the blocks with white background, and taxable items are in the blocks with the shaded background.

If your business sells any of the exempt items on the enclosed list, you will still charge 1 cent St. Clair County Education tax on these items. This 1 cent tax is for Education and is not included in the Severe Weather Sales Tax Holiday.

The St. Clair County Commission has joined with the State of Alabama in the Severe Weather Sales Tax Holiday regarding **SPECIFIC ITEMS** for exemption from the State 4 cent sales tax and the St. Clair County 1 cent Sales Tax, beginning 12:01 a.m. on Friday, Feb. 20, 2026 and ending 12:00 midnight on Sunday, Feb. 22, 2026.

This exemption DOES NOT include the St. Clair County 1 CENT EDUCATION TAX.

Each store location that is outside the city limits of Pell City will file a regular St. Clair County Sales and Use Tax Return Form **and** a St. Clair County Special Sales Tax Holiday Form for the month of February 2026. These returns will be due March 20, 2026. If your company has a reporting schedule that splits the dates of the sales tax holiday, then you will need to file both returns for both periods.

The Special Sales Tax Holiday form **cannot** be filed electronically. The paper return and payment must be mailed.
